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## Sharing Your Information

**We do not sell your personal information.**

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## Data Security

We implement appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect your personal information from unauthorised access, accidental loss, misuse, disclosure or alteration.

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## Data Retention

We retain personal information only for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes for which it was collected and to comply with legal obligations.

Typical retention periods include:

- Customer records – up to 7 years
- Financial records – up to 7 years
- Quotation and enquiry records – up to 24 months
- Marketing records – until consent is withdrawn

Retention periods may vary where required by law.

- Object to processing based on legitimate interests
- Request transfer of your data where applicable
- Withdraw consent where processing relies upon consent
